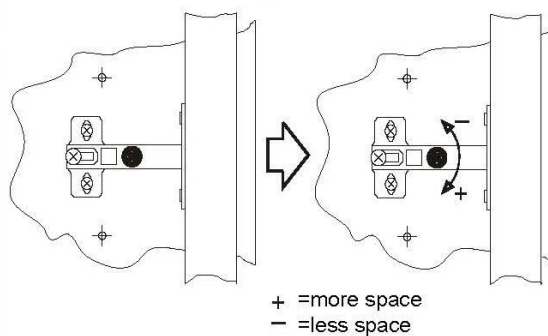
Adjust the door on the right depth using the middle hinge.

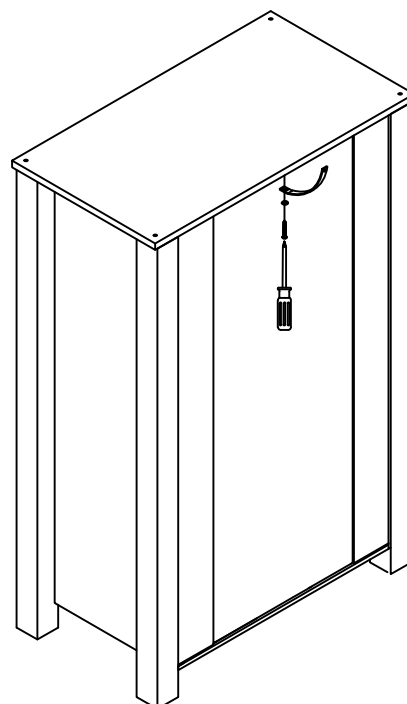
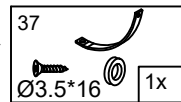

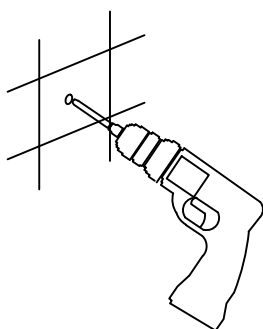
Safety belts

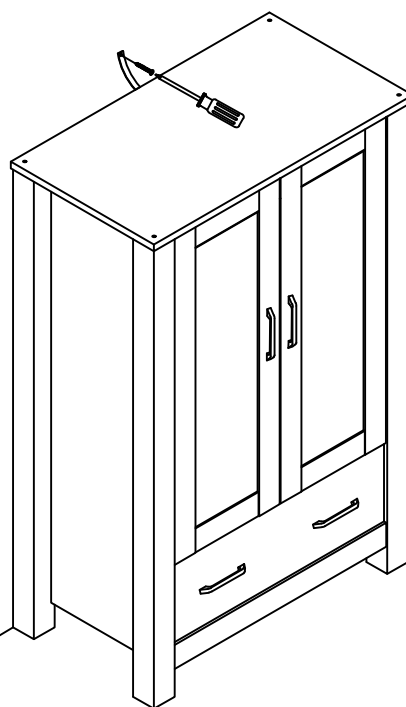

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAFE USE AND MAINTENANCE

1. WARNING: NEVER LEAVE YOUR CHILD UNATTENDED.

2. Do not allow children to climb on or in the wardrobe.
3. Make sure the wardrobe is situated on a clear firm and level surface
4. Never use the wardrobe if it is broken or damaged or there are parts missing.
5. Do not place the wardrobe in or near the vicinity of open fires or other sources of strong heat, such as gas or electric fires.
6. The wardrobe can be cleaned with a clean damp cloth. Do not use aggressive cleaning agents such as bleach or strong detergents.

8. Do not twist or pivot the wardrobe, if the wardrobe is to be moved always lift with at least two people.
